



RepManNet is a network of those members of staff of Austrian institutions who are in charge of repository management.

What are we doing?

RepManNet offers an exchange of experiences, special issues and challenges in regular meetings to prioritize key aspects of scientific digital repositories.

Lectures and workshops held by experts will consistently deepen its members' knowledge about repository management.

More than 130 people and more than 40 institutions are now members of this network.
